

NOTICE OF DECISION
KIRKTON WIND FARM LIMITED
ELECTRICITY ACT 1989
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (SCOTLAND) ACT 1997
THE ELECTRICITY WORKS (ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT) (SCOTLAND)
REGULATIONS 2017

As directed by regulation 23(4) of the Electricity Works (Environmental Impact Assessment) (Scotland) 2017, notice is hereby given that **Kirkton Wind Farm Ltd** (“the Company”) has been refused **consent by Scottish Ministers to construct and operate an 11 turbine wind farm and Battery Energy Storage known as Kirkton Energy Park, (with a ground to blade tip height of 149.9m metres), in lands approximately 2.1km to the south of Melvich**, in the relevant Planning Authority area of The Highland Council.

Scottish Ministers have also directed, under Section 57 (2) of the Town & Country Planning Act (Scotland) 1997, that planning permission is deemed to be refused.
